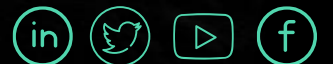

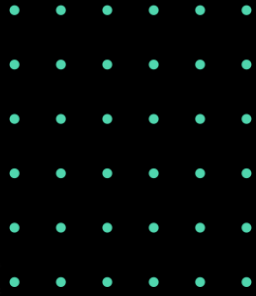
# About the Event

## Audience target:

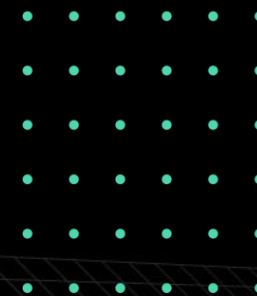

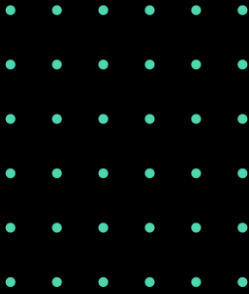
